Sunday School

This year's Diocesan-wide Lenten Drive will benefit two worthwhile programs:

- 1. **The Children of Haiti**. With the death toll over 200,000, recovery in Haiti will take far longer than the decades during which aid for the 1988 poured into Armenia. Children are affected with thousands left orphaned.
- 2. Gavar School, Armenia. This is the only school in all Armenia completely devoted to the education of children aged 6-18 with mental and physical disabilities. Gavar School was established in 1976 and has a current enrollment of 90 children with challenges ranging from autism to Down's Syndrome.

Once again, we ask that we open our hearts and be generous with our Lenten gift for these two causes.
